15:00 - 16:00 **Guided visit of the old city and the cathedral of Grasse**

Walking tour of about 1 hour in the company of a tour guide approved by the Ministry of Culture. The guide lets you in on all the secrets of Grasse, its development through time as well as its rich artistic history. In Grasse Cathedral, amongst other treasures you may admire two paintings attributed to Peter Paul Rubens, an altar piece attributed to the school of Louis Brea, a rare religious painting from Jean Honore Fragonard and four statues by Baillet.

Created in 1989, this unique museum is an integral part of the history of Grasse, cradle of the perfumery industry. It takes an anthropological approach to the international history of the use of scent and covers all its aspects: raw materials, manufacturing, innovations, trade, design and uses.
